## Rules Chart

- Preparatory**
  - Preparatory signal.
  - Rule 30.1 is in effect.
  - Rule 30.2 is in effect.
  - Rule 30.3 is in effect.
  - Rule 30.4 is in effect.
- Shortened Course**
  - The course has been shortened. Rule 33.2 is in effect.
- Recall Signals**
  - Individual
  - General recall. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal.
- Abandonment Signals**
  - All races that have started are abandoned. Return to the starting area. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is abandoned again or postponed.
  - All races are abandoned. Further signals ashore.
  - All races are abandoned. No more racing today.
- Postponement Signals**
  - Races not started are postponed. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is postponed again or abandoned.
  - Races not started are postponed. Further signals ashore.
  - Races not started are postponed. No more racing today.
- Other Signals**
  - The object displaying this signal replaces a missing mark.
  - Wear a personal flotation device (see rule 40).
  - Blue flag or shape. This race committee vessel is in position at the finishing line.
  - Ashore: A notice to competitors has been posted.
  - Afloat: Come within hail or follow
- Changing the Next**
  - The position of the next mark has been changed:
    - to starboard;
    - to port;
    - to increase the length of the leg;
    - to decrease the length of the leg.
