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Safety

Safety is of paramount importance on all Errwood SC courses. Water sports are hazardous by their nature and participants, parent or guardians must accept that there are risks, and the inevitable bumps and scrapes which happen during the thrills and spills of fast moving activities. Errwood SC will run RYA dinghy and Powerboat courses with reasonable skill and care using suitable qualified experienced persons. The Safe Systems of Work comprise, the ESC Operational Procedures and Risk Assessments which are reviewed on a regular basis. As a participant you must comply with the instructions given by Errwood SC instructors and its duly authorised staff, which will be in line with all health and safety policies and procedures, including those relating to fire and evacuation.

You accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own negligence.

You will not participate in the RYA Sailing Course whilst your ability to help or crew is impaired by alcohol, drugs or whilst otherwise unfit to participate

Errwood SC, its servants, agents, instructors and principal do not accept any responsibility for any loss damage or injury suffered by any persons and/or their property arising out of or during the course unless such loss or damage was caused by or resulted from negligence. It is recommended that students take out their own accident insurance.

Limitation

Any claim arising from or in connection with this Agreement to be brought by one party against the other shall be brought within six months of the completion date of the course or delivery, failing which such claims shall be time-barred.

Misconduct

You understand that the Errwood SC Principal or the Senior Instructor may exclude anyone from a particular session and evict anyone from the premises who refuses to comply with these Attendance Form Terms or who misconducts themselves in any way or who causes damage or annoyance to other persons.

Cancellation

You understand that Errwood SC may cancel or postpone the sailing course at any stage in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise. If the course is cancelled you will be offered a place on the next mutually convenient course or a full refund of the course fee. If you have to cancel please give as much notice as possible, you will be offered a place on the next mutually convenient course or a full course refund. If you cancel within 24 hours of the course then no refund will be offered.

Complaints

If you encounter a problem or issue during the course please report it to the Senior Instructor responsible for the course, who will try and resolve such problem or issue as soon as possible.
